VILLAGE HEALTH SANITATION AND NUTRITION COMMITTEE

- About 17900 VHSNCs out of 19148 VHSNCs are regularly monitoring the village level services.
- Continuous supportive supervision being provided to strengthen village health monitoring.
- Regular review of Swasth Panchayat Samanvyaks is being done at State level to assess the progress of VHSNC and capacity building inputs provided.
- As per an internal assessment report, average membership per VHSNC has gone up from 11 to 22 per VHSNC. Improving attendance and participation enabling VHSNC in proper monitoring and collective action. Qualitative assessment of VHSNC carried out.
- Collective action against gender based violence: This initiative has been reemphasized to ensure discussion on women rights and planning on violence against women in each VHSNC of the state. In this direction, around 38000 cases were taken-up by Mitanins and VHSNCs during the year.
